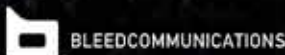

This spring the Tryzub Ensemble finished off the Razom 2 tour with a bang; a hometown performance in Calgary on February 9th and then flew out to Winnipeg for the final performance on March 23rd! These were the final two performances with Saskatoon's Yevshan, Regina's Tavria, and Winnipeg's Rusalka. Over 100 dancers joined together to put on a dazzling show featuring each of the four groups, with the highlight being the joint performance of Virsky's Pryvit and Hopak.

Each weekend brought the dancers back together from across the prairies, and after months apart, rehearsal was required. As familiar faces walked into the studio, friendships continued to grow and develop. During practices of the joint dances, as steps were remembered and arm positions clarified, you could feel a true energy growing in the room as something amazing was being brought together.

The show days brought with it long hours of warm-up, tech rehearsals on stage, and preparing costumes. Nerves and emotions began to grow



as the minutes drew closer to the start of the show. Dancers in a wide variety of costumes began to gather on stage and take their positions, finally the curtain went up and everything began to fall into place. As the finale approached, the excitement backstage grew larger and larger. The final minutes before the start of Hopak were a chaos of poyas tying, headpiece checking, and quick costume changing (some dancers with only 45 seconds). But as the iconic music started and over 50 dancers flew out onto stage, the exhilarating rush of performing Virsky's Hopak with that many people took over and it became a truly unforgettable experience. When the curtain finally dropped at the end of the show, hugs were exchanged between new and old friends and the sweat and hard work all became worth it.



The success of the Razom 2 tour was the ability for four different Ukrainian dance organizations to come together to create something better. After more than a year of planning, the end goal had finally been achieved and that was to create "A Fusion of Ukrainian Dance". As a result of the tour, friendships were formed from across the Canadian prairies that will last a lifetime!

Interview with an Alumni Peter Woytiuk

1. What was the time period you danced with the Ensemble?

I danced from January 1995 - August 1998, September 2003 - July 2004, June 2012 - July 2012. There would be more but they stopped returning my calls.

2. Do you still keep in touch with your fellow Ensemble members?

Yes. Some are tired of hearing from me.

3. What did you enjoy about dancing with Tryzub?

The late nights, the early mornings, and the friends who know more about me than I do.

4. Why did you continue to dance even when it might have conflicted with other activities?



If you have to ask 'why' then there's no answer I can give you that will make any sense.

5. Which dance was your favourite and why?

Hopak because of the 'solos', no big surprise. Hutzul was always fun because of the choreography. Chronik's Transcarpathian was also great because I was never ever in it and it was a chance to catch my breath during any show.

6. Was there someone specific who had a profound effect on your success as a dancer and how did they influence your development?

Blaine Wicentovich, Boyan Blocka and George Chronik. I looked up to Blaine and Boyan when I first joined as they were both excellent dancers who pushed me to be better at what I did. Also, neither of them owe me money like that Horbachewski guy does. George Chronik was an excellent teacher and was a lot of fun in the rehearsal hall; I was fortunate enough to continue dancing under him even after my time with Tryzub.

7. Do you have a memorable Tryzub moment to share?

The look on my parents' face when I said I travelling across the country with a performing group, actually

It is a lot of work and a lot of time but, in the words of Jackson Browne, "Once the lights come up and you hear that crowd, you'll remember why you came."
